⁵Summary - Changes in 2010:

In 2010, the Saint Paul Public Library experienced a budget reduction that impacted open hours and staff. As a result, the Library reduced its hours by 6% and full-time equivalent staff by 10%.

Library usage has been affected. In 2010, there was a decrease in visitors and circulation.

The West Seventh Library was closed and renovated from January to April 2010.

Saint Anthony Park and Merriam Park Libraries lost Sunday hours. Dayton's Bluff and Rice Street Libraries gained Sunday hours to support Homework Centers.

⁶Library partnered with the Debra S. Fish library of the Think Small organization. Fish Library materials circulate around the state through the Saint Paul Public Library.

⁷A new Wi-Fi network was installed in 2013 and again in 2016. Annual figures are not comparable with figures from previous years.

⁸Changes in 2014:

Capital projects in 2014 impacted library use.

Sun Ray Library was closed and renovated from January 1 to November 8, 2014.

Highland Park Library was closed and renovated from January 1 to November 16, 2014.

Arlington Hills Library was closed during relocation from March 15 to May 22, 2014.

Merriam Park and Hayden Heights Libraries gained 13 hours per week from January 1 to September 1, 2014.
