Library Go is Saint Paul Public Library's virtual library card for students. All students in Saint Paul Public Schools, and in many charter and private schools, automatically get a library card when they enroll in school. It's easy to use and impossible to lose.

With Library Go, students can check out up to ten physical items. Online, they can get homework help from a tutor, find primary resources using our databases, find a book to read, or download an audiobook

We are a fine free library, and with Library Go, there is no financial risk to families.
